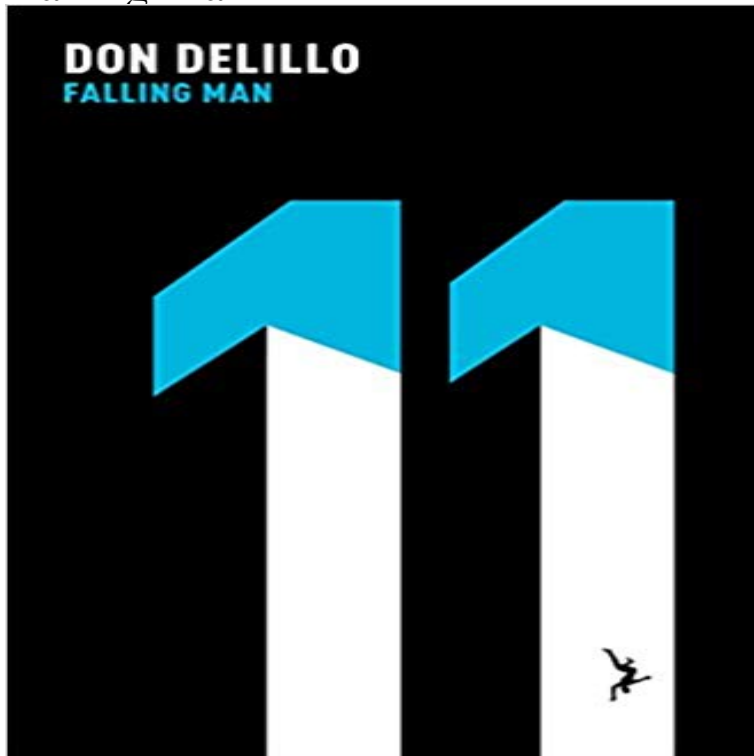


Falling Man
