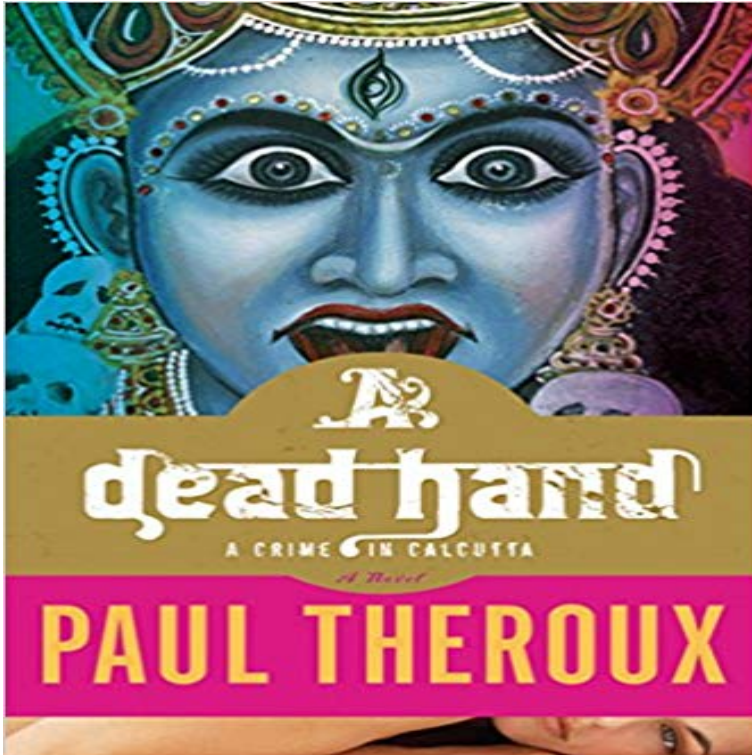


## A Dead Hand: A Crime in Calcutta
