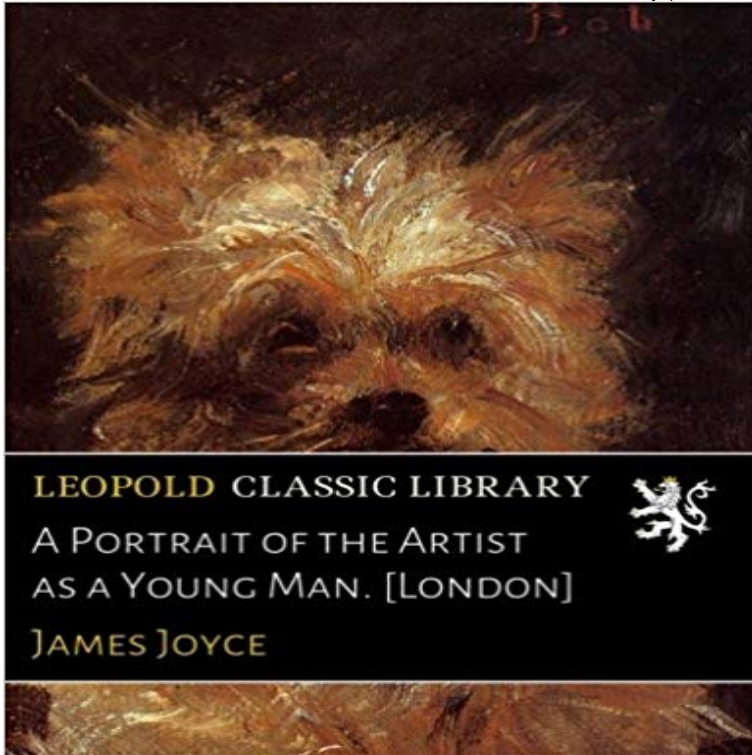


A Portrait of the Artist as a Young Man. [London]
