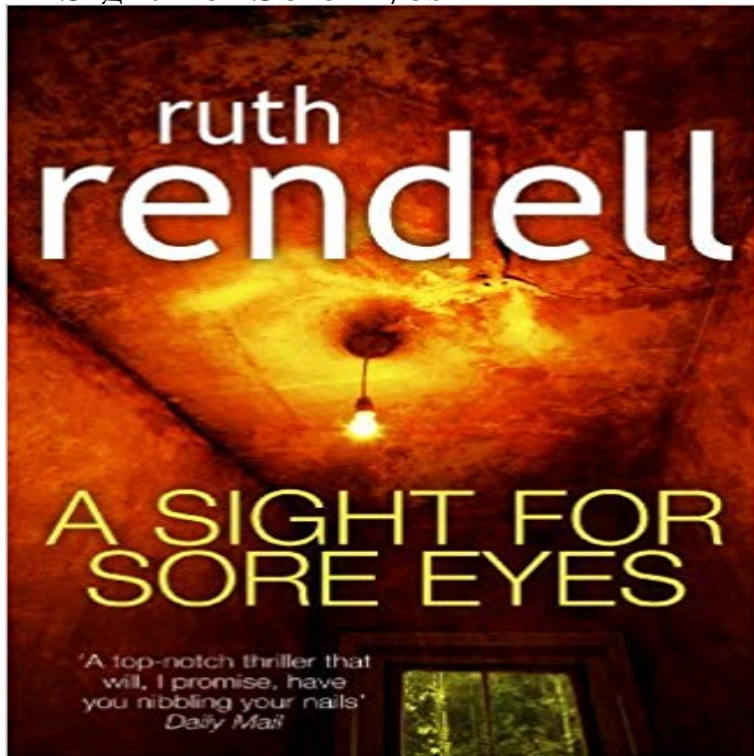


A Sight For Sore Eyes
