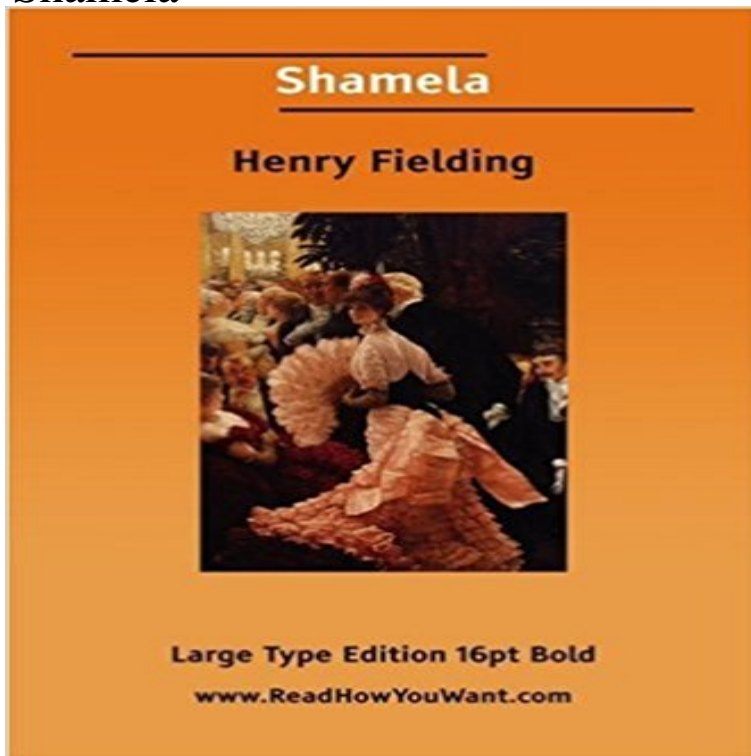


Shamela
