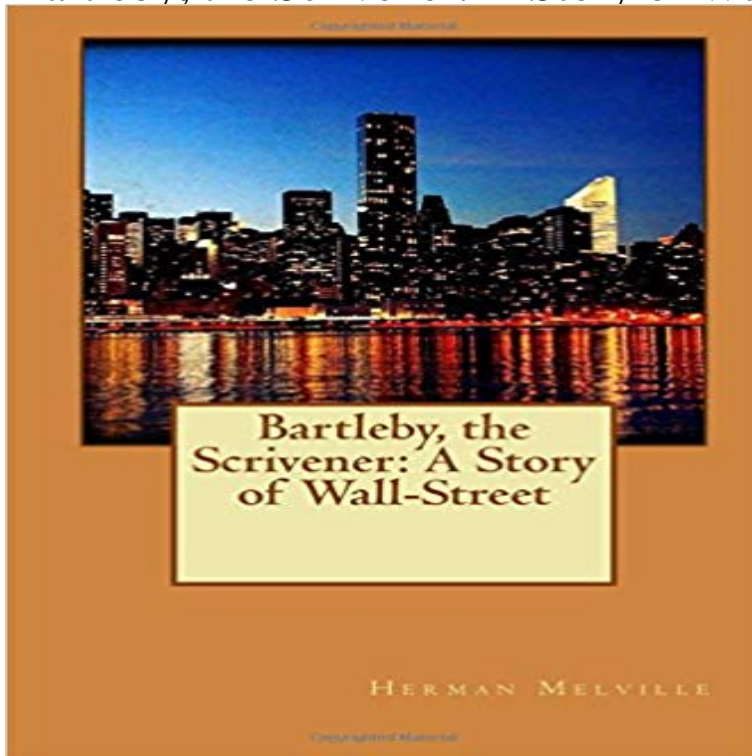


Bartleby, the Scrivener: A Story of Wall-Street
