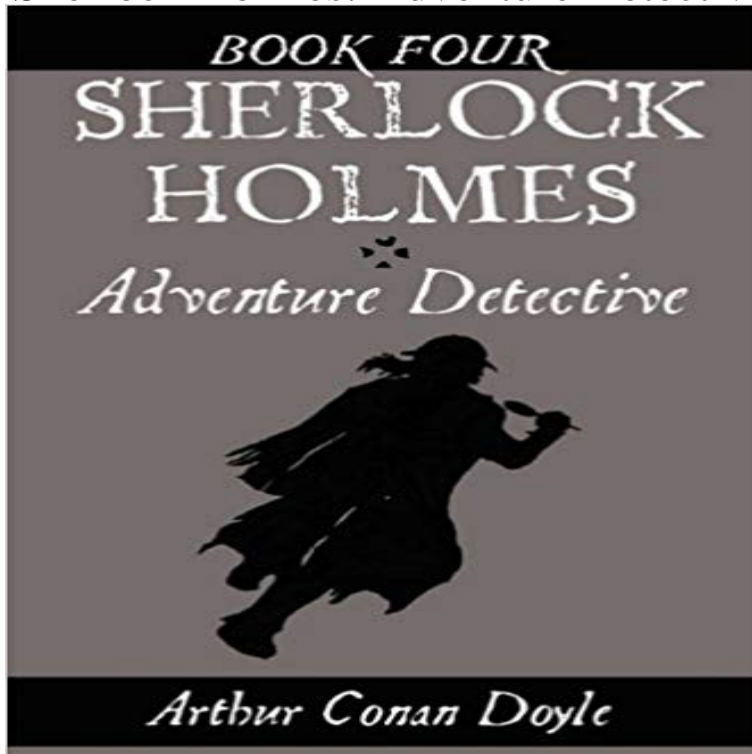


Sherlock Holmes: Adventure Detective, Book Four
