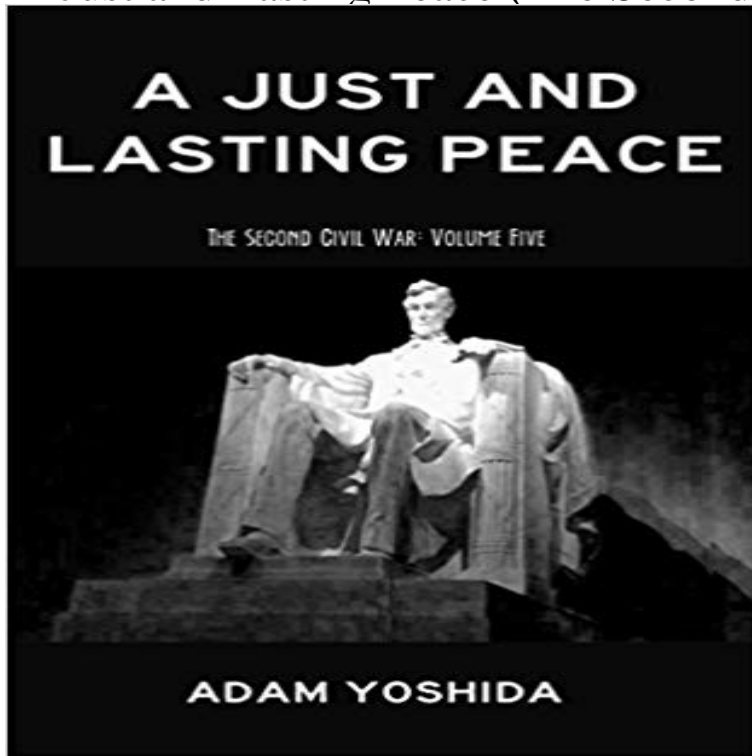


A Just and Lasting Peace (The Second Civil War Book 5)
