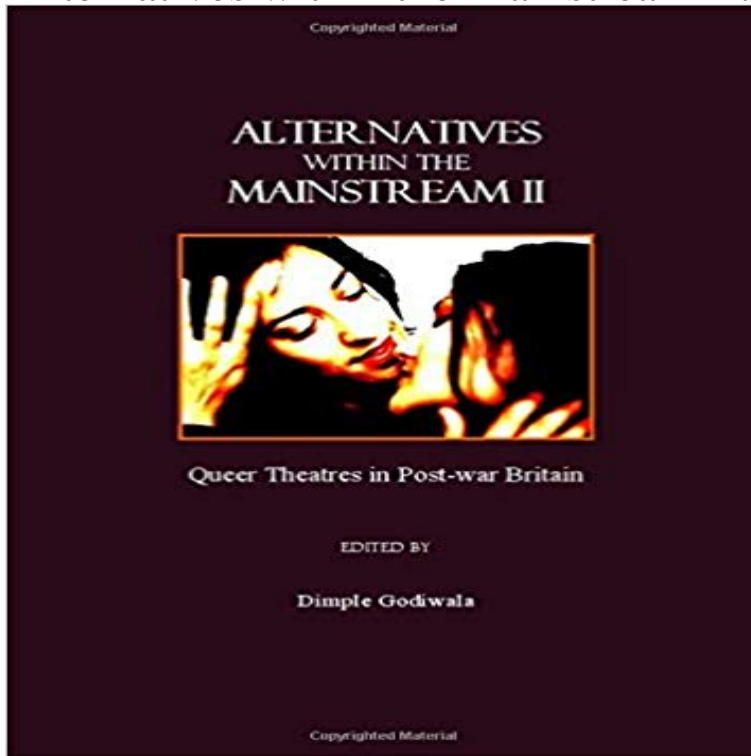


Alternatives within the Mainstream II: Queer Theatres in post-war Britain

The two volumes celebrate the plurality on the post-war British stage in terms of class, gender, race and sexualities.
