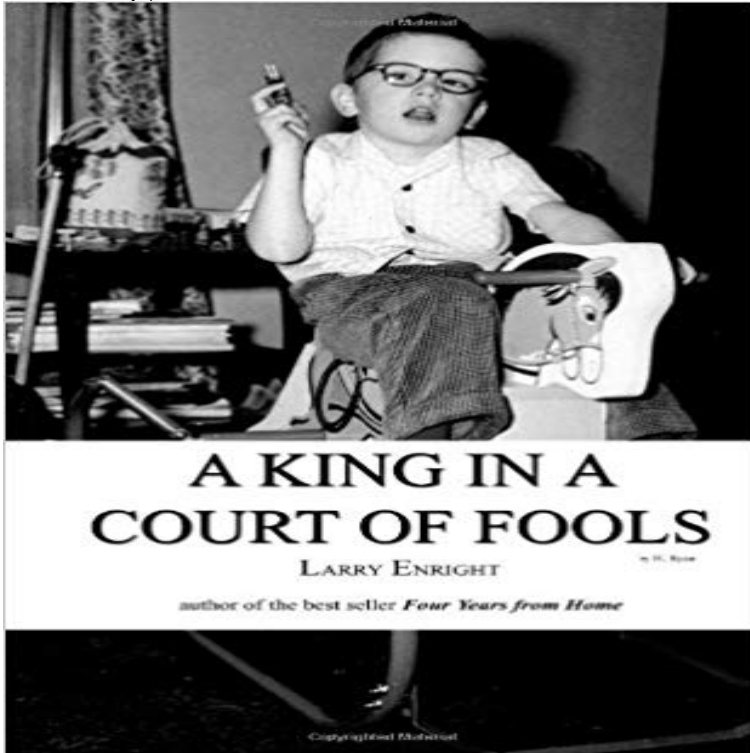


A King in a Court of Fools
