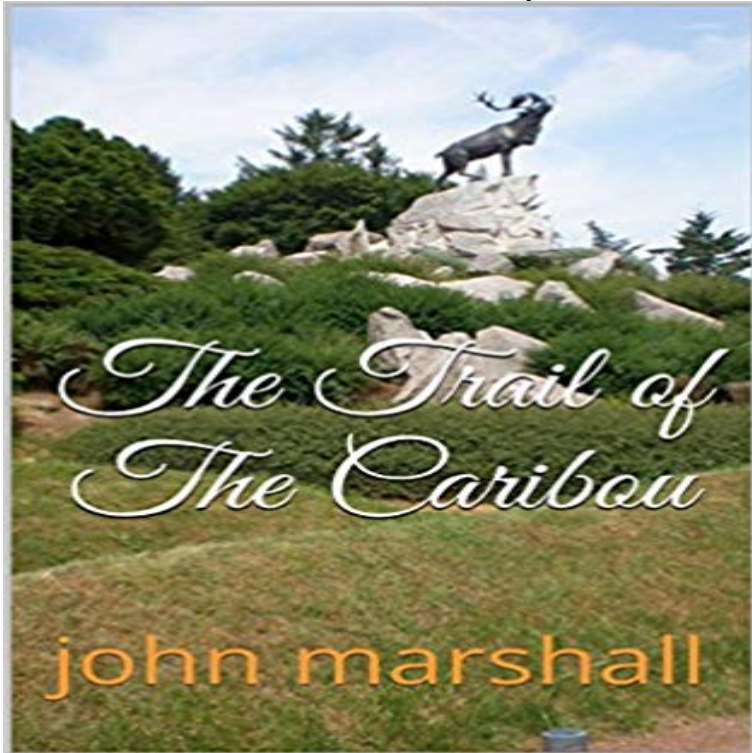


The Trail of The Caribou: john marshall



A partially true story of peoples lives during two world wars, revealing their secrets and the sacrifices they made. In the summer of 1914 Europe was in turmoil, Great Britain and France declared war on Germany after Kaiser Wilhelm the second sent troops into Belgium. With the countries of the British empire also declaring war on Germany and their allies , in support of Great Britain and France, the Dominion of Newfoundland and Labrador were first to respond, initially sending five hundred troops that year to be trained in Scotland. The following year three young enthusiastic Newfoundlanders Harry Murray, Joe Walker and Tommy Winton left home to volunteer for the army. having never been further than St. Johns in their own country the young recruits were shipped off to Scotland with C. Company, arriving there in February 1915, a shortage of khaki material saw the regiment having to resort to wearing a blue material for their putties(leggings) , thereafter the regiment assumed the nickname `The Blue Putties.` Of their regimental emblem, `The Caribou` the Newfoundland soldiers were fiercely proud. Now in Scotland the Royal Newfoundland regiment were billeted in the historic Edinburgh Castle, taking on guard duties there in the absence of the Scottish regiments now engaged in the war in Europe and the Middle East. The young soldiers thousands of miles from their homeland, embark on relationships, before going off to fight in a horrific conflict that would last for years. I
