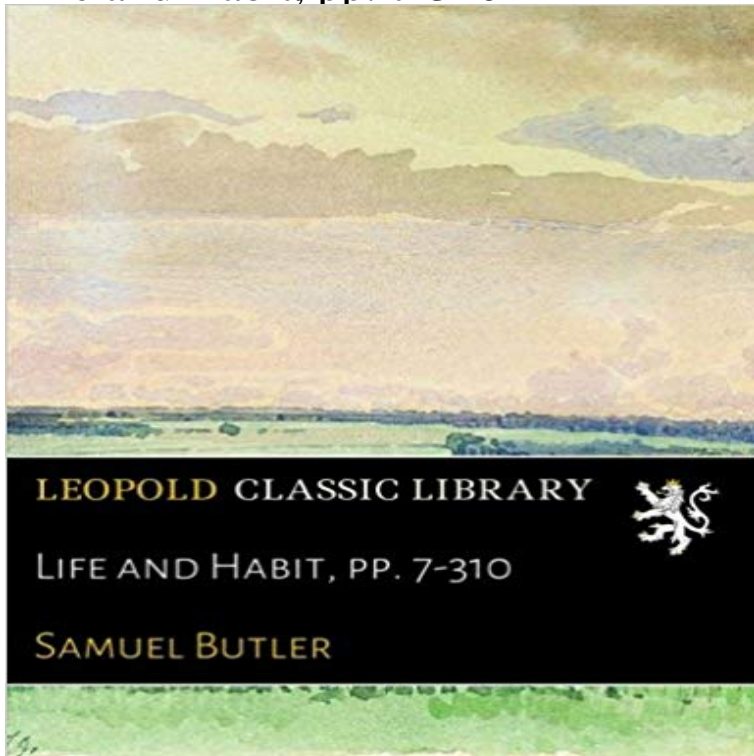


Life and Habit, pp. 7-310
