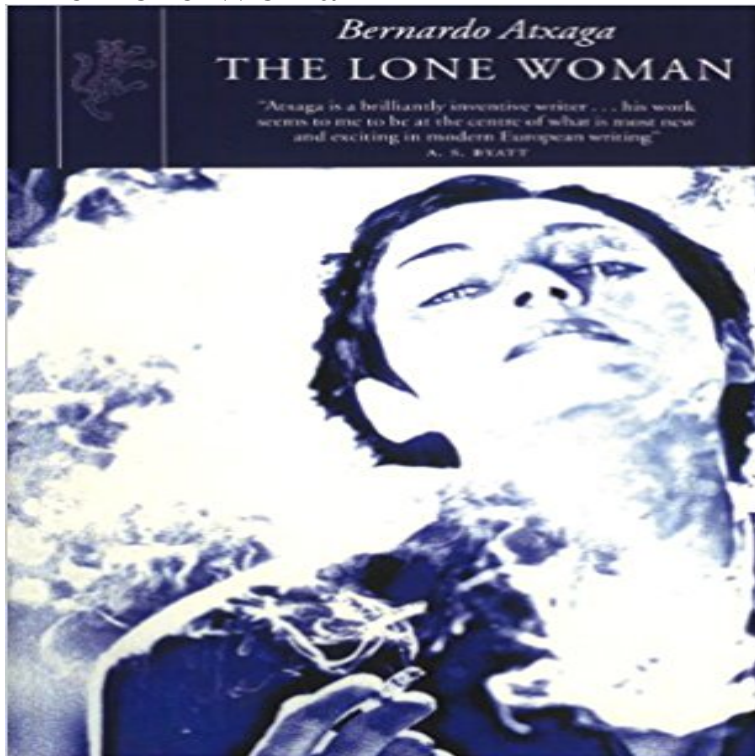


## The Lone Woman
