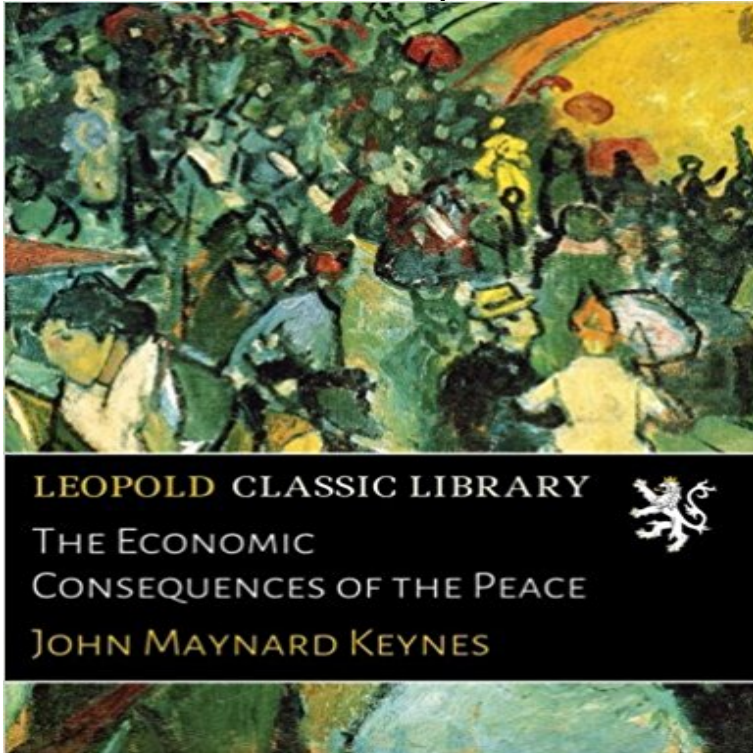


The Economic Consequences of the Peace
