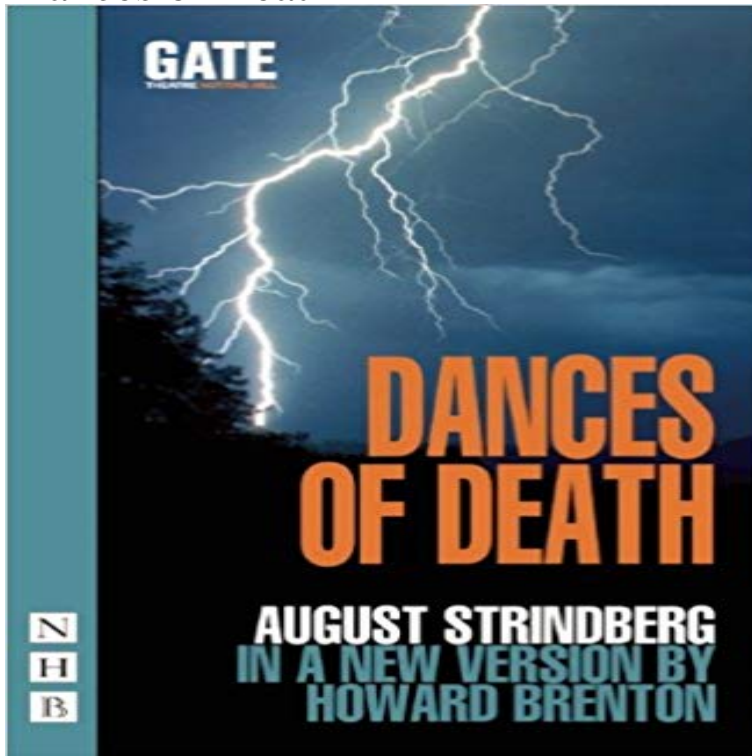


Dances of Death
