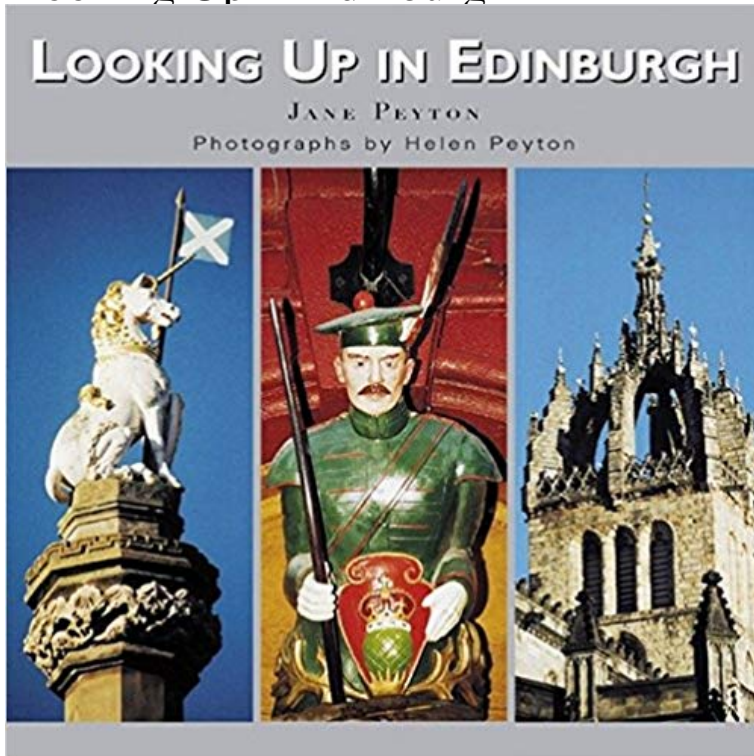


## Looking Up in Edinburgh
