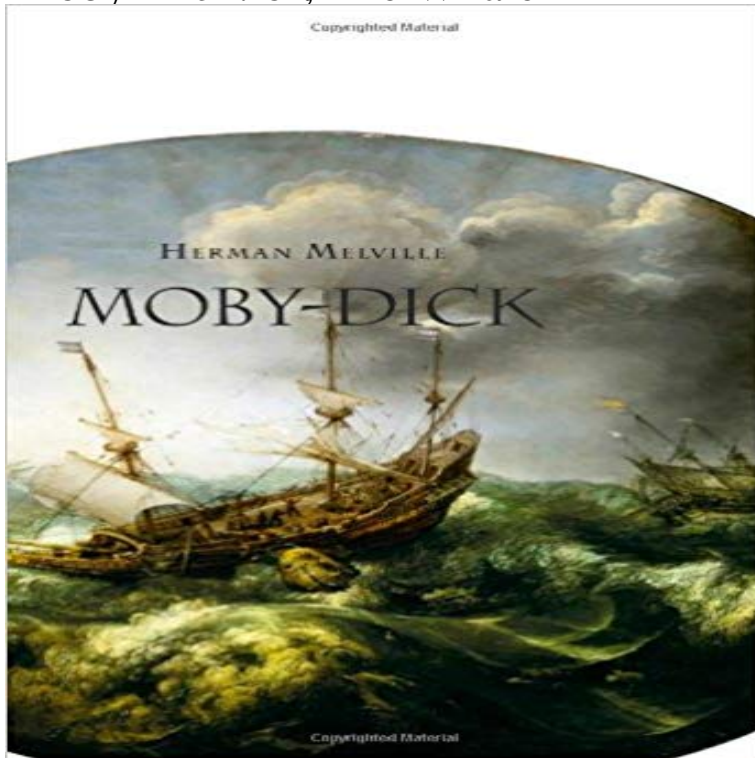


Moby-Dick: or, The Whale
