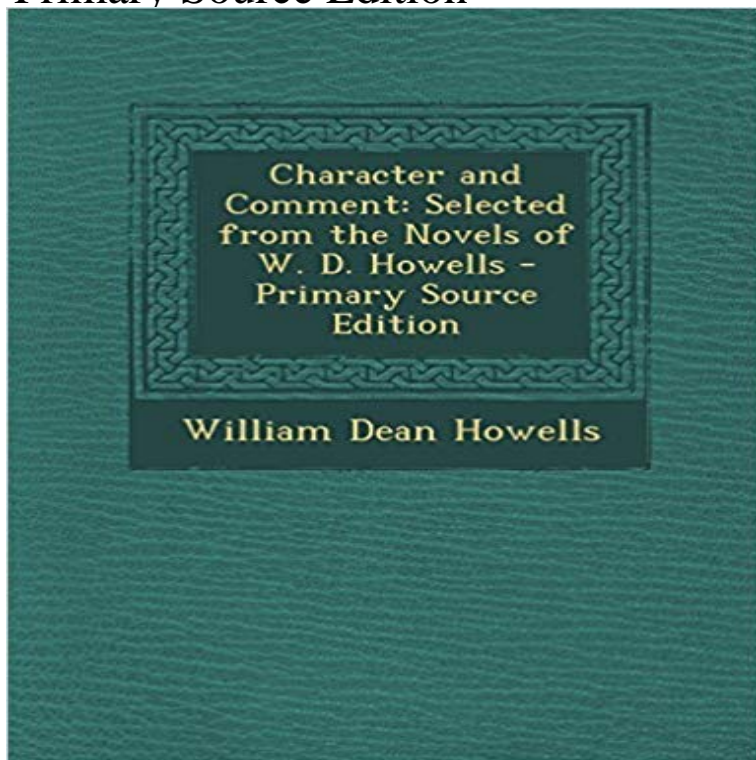


Character and Comment: Selected from the Novels of W. D. Howells - Primary Source Edition
