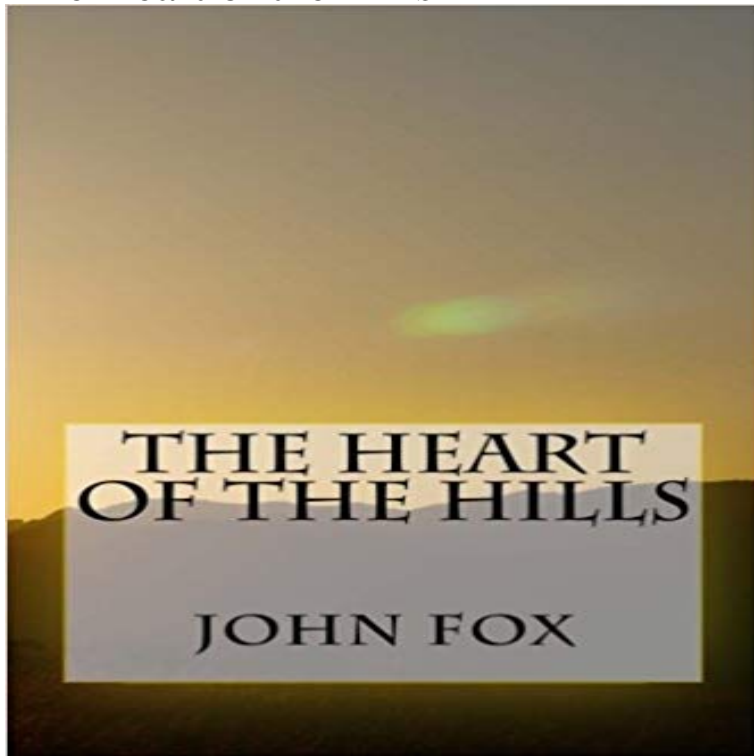


The Heart of the Hills
