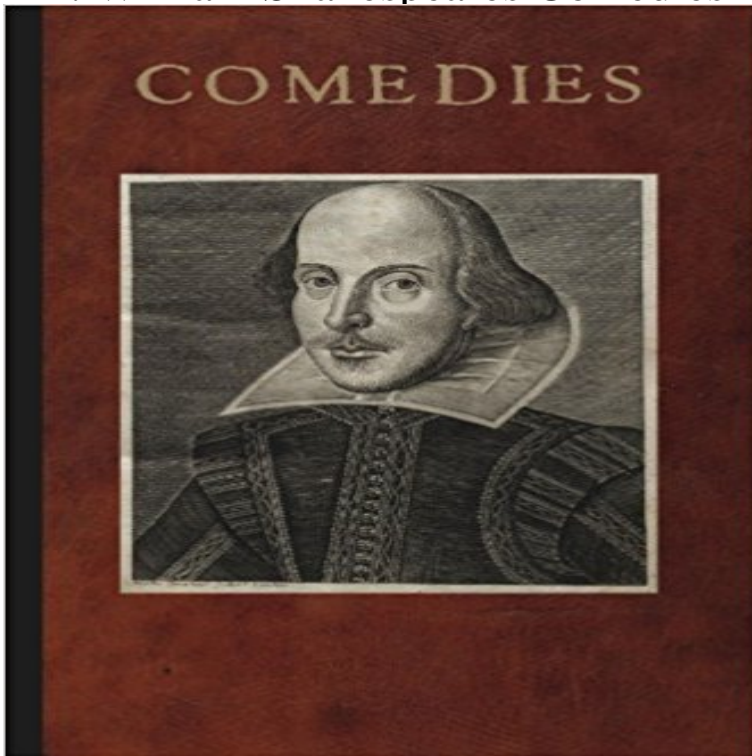


Mr. William Shakespeares Comedies
