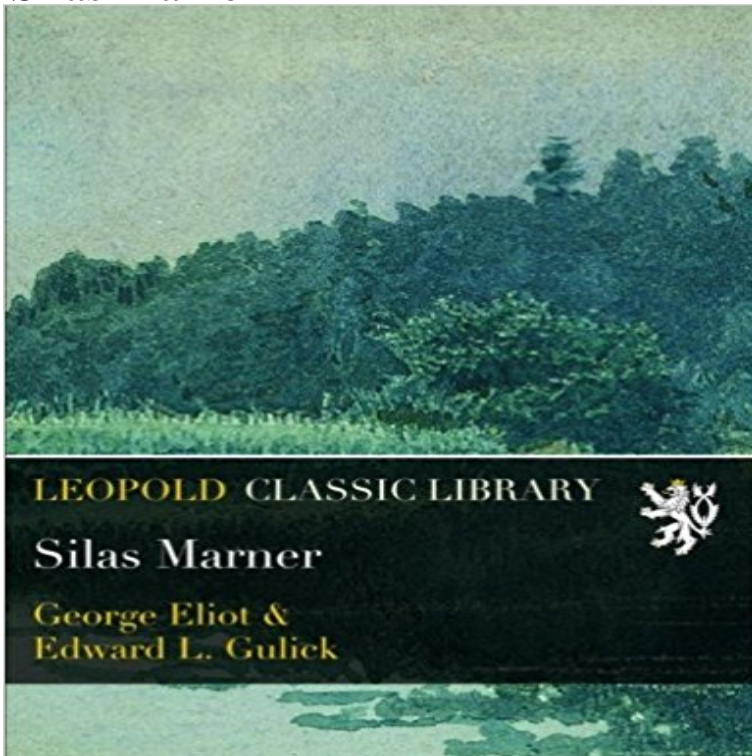


Silas Marner
