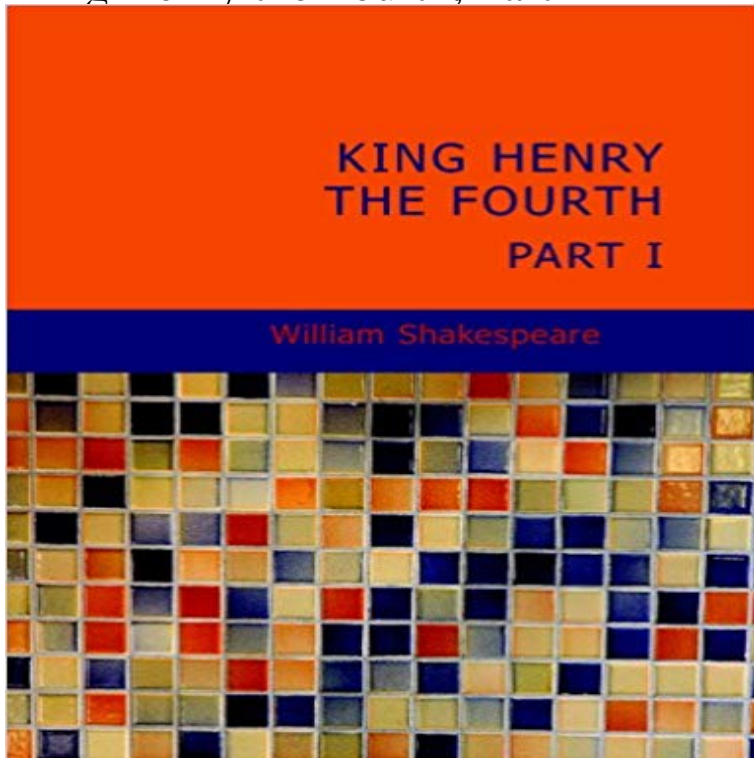


# King Henry the Fourth, Part I
