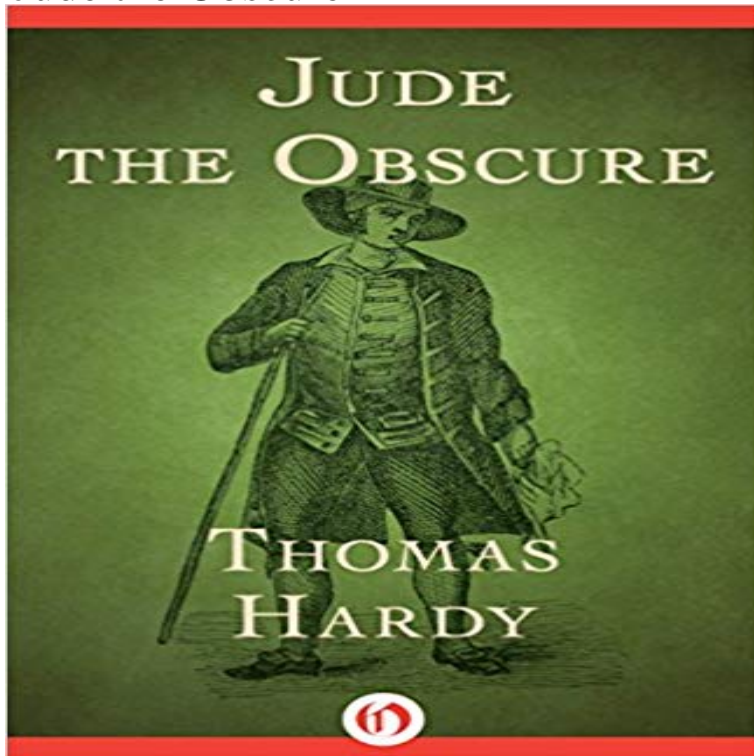


Jude the Obscure
