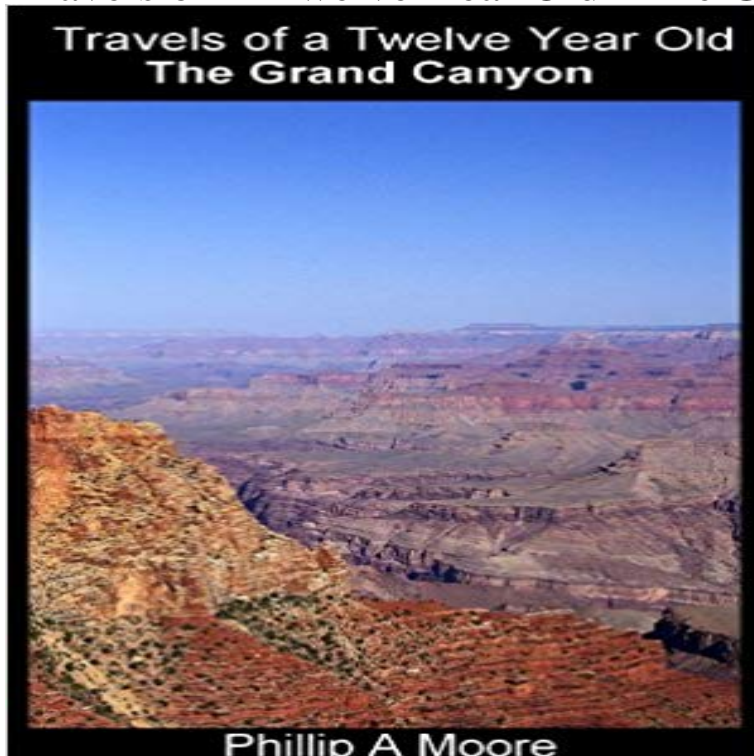


Travels of A Twelve Year Old - The Grand Canyon
