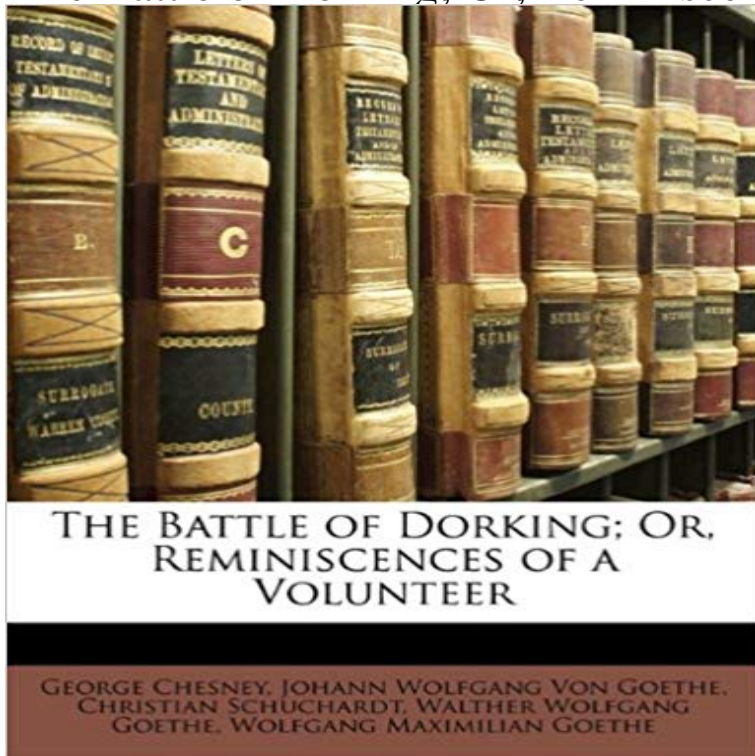


The Battle of Dorking; Or, Reminiscences of a Volunteer
