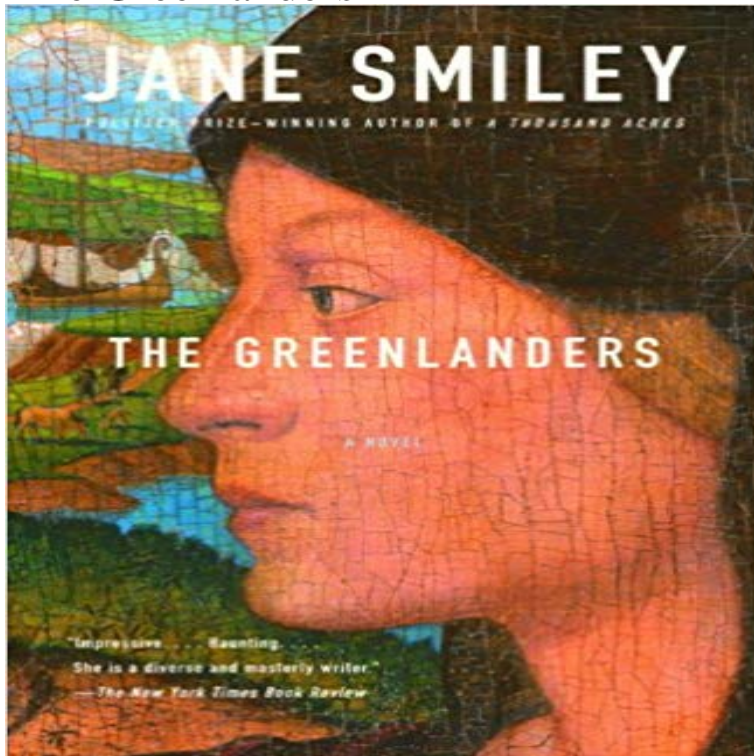


The Greenlanders
