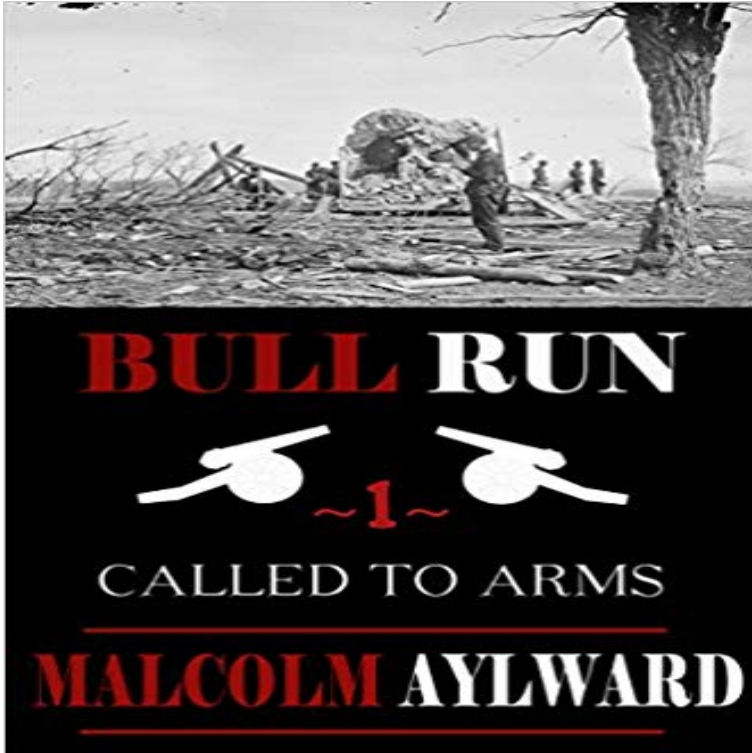


BULL RUN: PART ONE: CALLED TO ARMS
