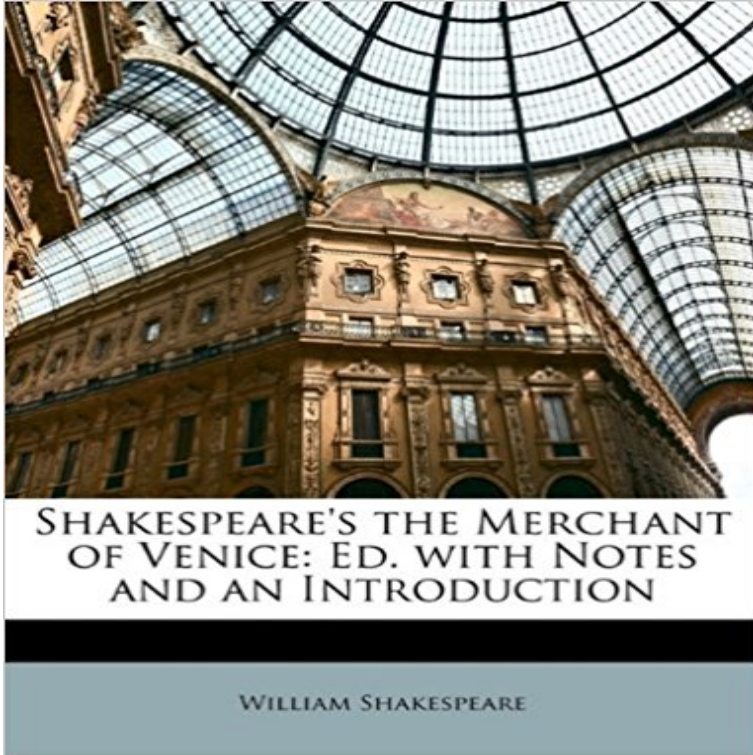


# Shakespeares the Merchant of Venice: Ed. with Notes and an Introduction
