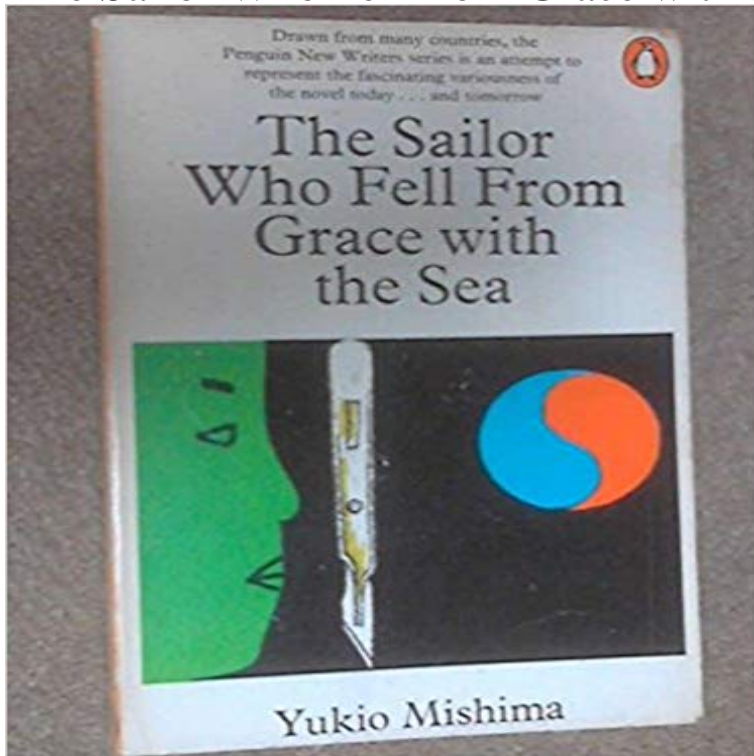


The Sailor Who Fell from Grace with the Sea
