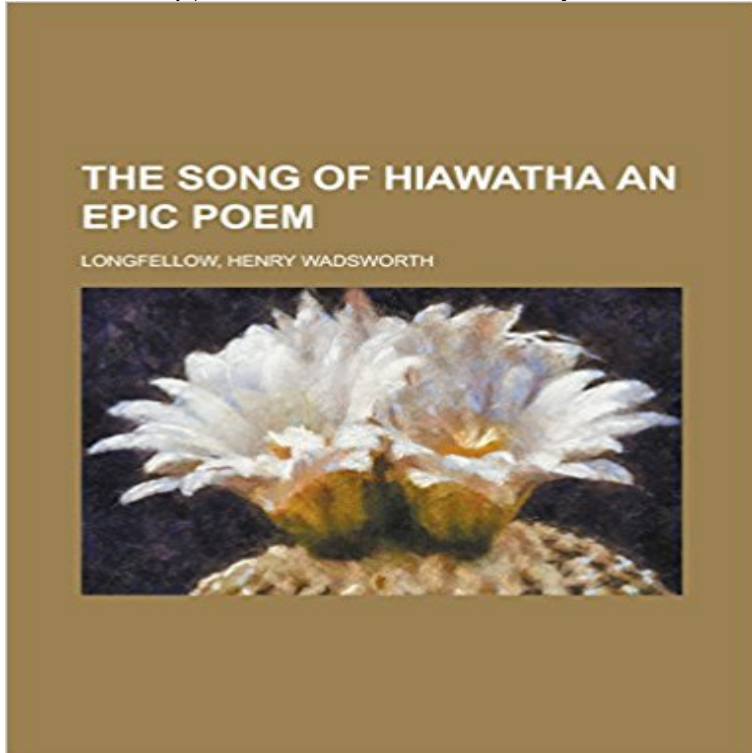


The Song of Hiawatha An Epic Poem
