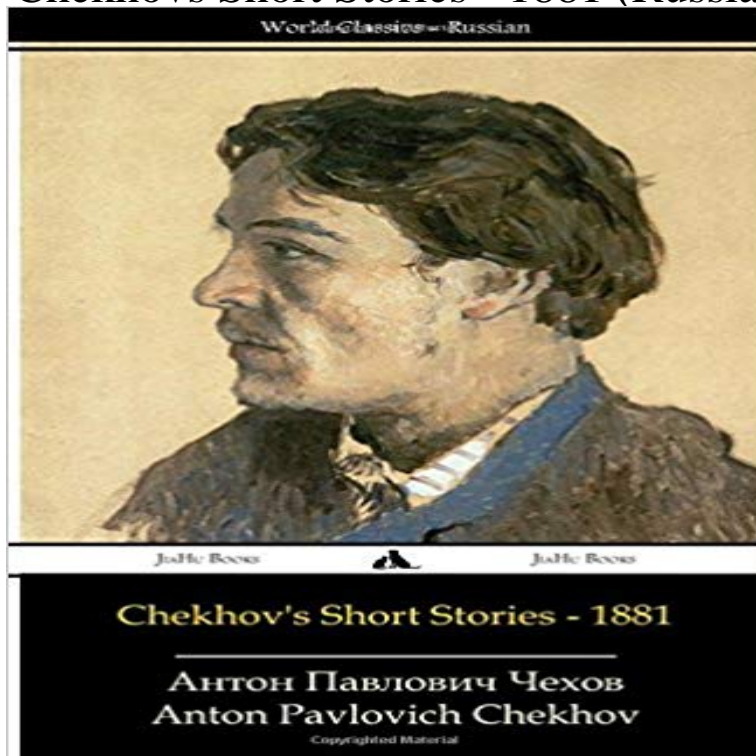


Chekhov's Short Stories - 1881 (Russian Edition)
