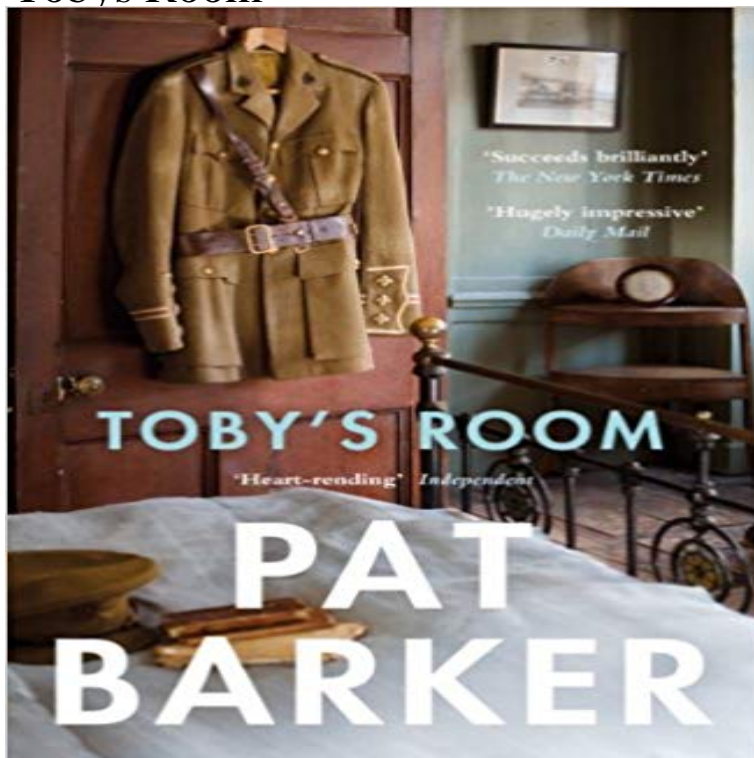


Tobys Room
