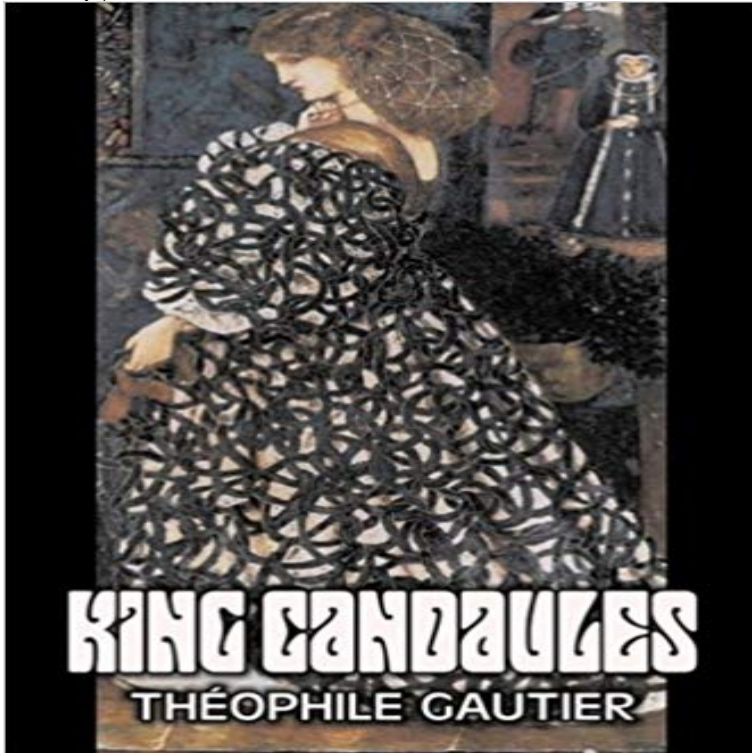


King Candaules
