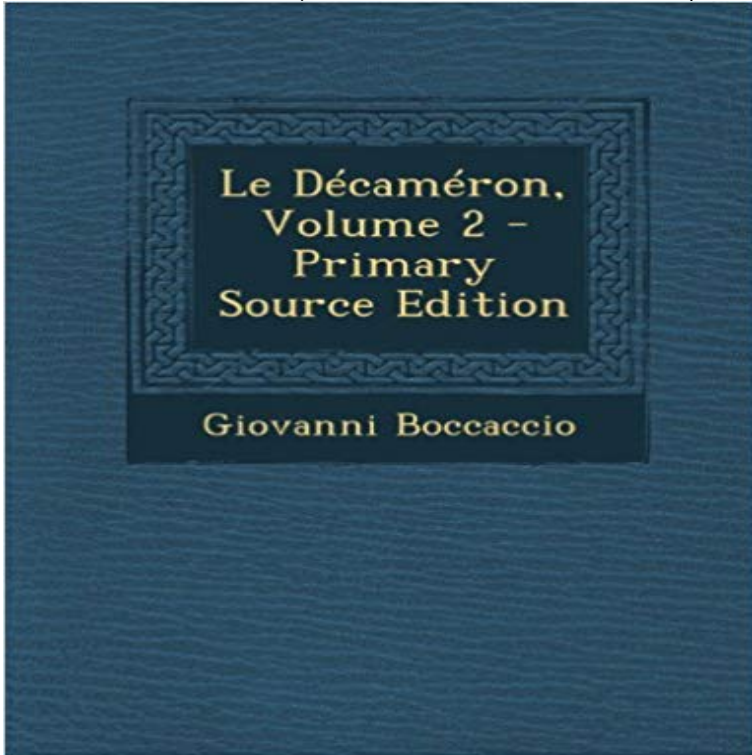


## Le Decameron, Volume 2 - Primary Source Edition (French Edition)
