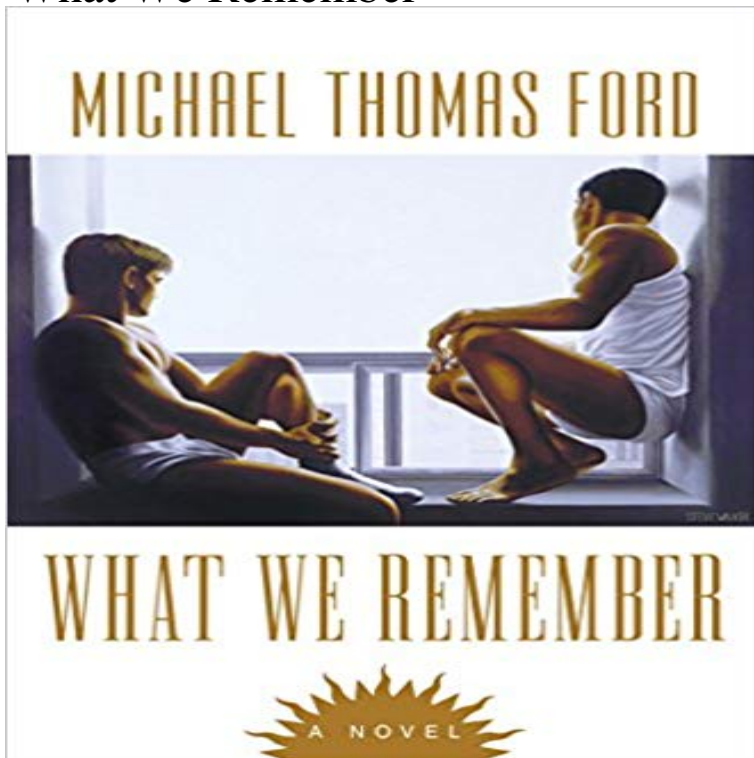


What We Remember
