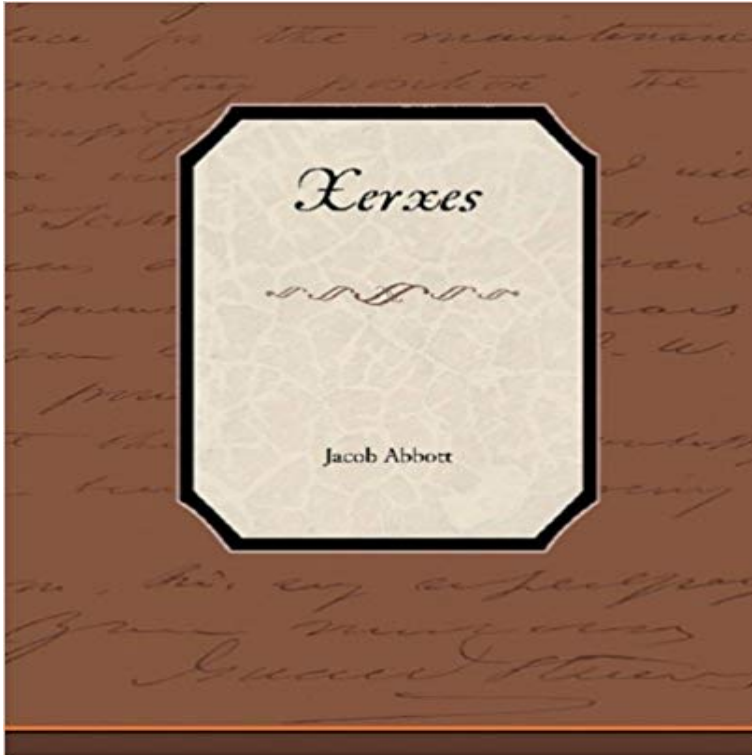


Xerxes
